An Memorandum of Understanding was signed between ITI Limited and Centre for Development of Telematics (C-DoT) at ITI Corporate Office on July 7, 2022. The signed agreement was exchanged by Shri D. Venkateswarlu, Additional Charge CMD & Director (Production) and Shri Daniel Jebaraj, Director (C-DoT) in the presence of Shri Harwesh Bhatia, Member (Services), DCC, Dr. Rajesh Sharma, DDG (SU), Shri P K Singh, DDG (SA) and Shri Mukesh Mangal, DDG (SA-II) from DoT, Shri Rajeev Srivastava, Director (Finance), Shri Rakesh Chandra Tiwari, Director (Marketing) from ITI Limited and Shri R Prakash, Group Leader-4G Projects, C-DoT.



The signed agreement aims to establish a framework of cooperation for Technology transfer of LTE/ LTE-A/ 4G technology based Wireless Communication Systems that will provide networks of upcoming technologies to different telecom service providers in the country and also address business opportunities globally. ITI will produce the 4G upgradable to 5G Radio Access Network (RAN) and related equipment. The MoU will bring synergy between the two organizations and focuses to drive the 'Make in India', and 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat' initiatives of the Government of India.
