Our Commitment

ITI Limited shall:

- Identify, assess, and manage cyber security risks in a structured and risk-proportionate manner
- Implement appropriate technical and organisational controls to protect information assets
- Comply with applicable statutory and regulatory requirements, including the Information Technology Act, 2000, CERT-In directions, and the Digital Personal Data Protection Act, 2023
- Ensure timely detection, reporting, and response to cyber security incidents
- Foster a culture of cyber security awareness among all employees and authorised users
- Continuously review and improve its cyber security posture in alignment with the evolving threat landscape

This policy applies to all information systems, networks, applications, and data managed by ITI Limited, and is binding on all employees, contractors, consultants, and third parties with access to organisational systems.
