Shri Rajesh Rai, CMD, ITI Limited gave an overview of the Company. Shri Rai also highlighted the progress of ongoing projects.



ITI Limited-Led Consortium Emerges as L1 worth Rs. 4134 Crore for BharatNet Project for Middle Mile Network

ITI Limited, the country's first PSU post-independence and a premier telecom manufacturing company along with its consortium partner has emerged as the lowest bidder (L1) for three packages worth Rs. 4134 crore in the BharatNet Phase-3 Project. The state-owned telecom equipment manufacturer won the contracts for Package 8 covering Himachal Pradesh, Package 9 covering West Bengal and Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Package 15 for North Eastern Region (NER-II) covering States Arunachal Pradesh, Nagaland and Manipur.



ITI Limited-led Consortium has succeeded in these three packages, out of a total of 16 packages covering the length and breadth of the country. BSNL had invited tenders for Design, Supply, Construction, Installation, Upgradation, Operation and Maintenance of Middle Mile Network of BharatNet in the 16 Packages/Circles. BharatNet Phase-3 Project is envisaged for the Development - Creation, Upgradation, Operation and Maintenance of Middle Mile Network of BharatNet on Design Build Operate and Maintain (DBOM) Model. BharatNet project is funded by the Universal Service Obligation Fund (USOF) under the Department of Telecommunications (DoT). The project aims to bridge the 'digital divide' by delivering high-speed broadband connectivity with bandwidth of 100 Mbps to all Gram Panchayats (GPs) and Villages in India ensuring equitable access to online services for all, especially those in rural areas. The project encompasses connecting all 640000 Villages, Blocks and Gram Panchayats across India with high-speed broadband internet connectivity.

Commenting on this new development, Shri Rajesh Rai, Chairman and Managing Director, ITI Limited said, "We are delighted to have emerged as the lowest bidder (L1) for the prestigious BharatNet phase-3 project in the states of Himachal Pradesh, West Bengal, Andaman & Nicobar Islands and NER-II States Arunachal Pradesh, Nagaland and Manipur. BharatNet is a nation building project and it gives us immense satisfaction to be part of the execution of this gigantic project". Shri Rai further stated that, "BharatNet project aims to empower rural India which will lead to creation of jobs, opportunities and growth. Needless to say, high-speed internet will be a big boon for students in rural areas and will contribute towards addressing issues like digital-divide among the rural population. ITI Limited is focused on assisting Government of India in its initiatives to connect urban as well as rural parts of India seamlessly". ITI Limited has the vast experience in execution of optical fiber network projects across India for BharatNet and is already successfully executing optical fiber network projects worth approximately Rs. 5400 Crore across Tamil Nadu, Maharashtra and Gujarat under earlier phases of BharatNet.

ITI Limited is the Project Implementation Agency (PIA) for MahaNet-I (BharatNet Phase II) in Maharashtra. In Gujarat, ITI Limited is executing two packages of BharatNet Phase II for Gujarat Fibre Grid Network Limited (GFGNL) in Gujarat, BharatNet Phase II for TANFINET (Tamil Nadu Fibrenet Corporation Limited) in Tamil Nadu.

ITI Limited Bags Contract worth Rs. 95 Crore for Mining Digital Transformation & Surveillance System (MDTSS) in Uttarakhand

ITI Limited, country's first PSU post-independence and premier telecom manufacturing company has received a contract worth approximately Rs. 95 Crore from Directorate of Geology & Mining, Government of Uttarakhand for Mining Digital Transformation & Surveillance System (MDTSS) project. The Uttarakhand Government envisaged this project for effective prevention of illegal mining

and mineral transportation and to increase its revenue in the state. As part of this contract, ITI Limited will be the work agency for development, implementation and maintenance of Mining Digital Transformation & Surveillance System (MDTSS) in the districts of Dehradun, Haridwar, Udham Singh Nagar and Nainital. Accordingly, a Memorandum of



Understanding (MoU) was signed between ITI Limited and Government of Uttarakhand worth Rs. 95 Crore. As per the Contract, the systems will be installed at 40 check gates across Dehradun, Haridwar, Nainital and Udham Singh Nagar. Dehradun will have 8 check gates, Haridwar 13, Nainital 10 and Udham Singh Nagar 9.

The new system is equipped with bullet cameras, RFID radars and LED floodlights will not only help monitor illegal mining activities but also boost the state government's revenue. Besides, a Mining State Control Centre (MSCC) will be set up in Dehradun, along with mini command centres at district headquarters in Dehradun, Haridwar, Nainital and Udham Singh Nagar.

Speaking on the occasion of signing this contract, Shri Rajesh Rai, Chairman and Managing Director, ITI Limited said, "It gives us a great sense of satisfaction to see that the Government of Uttarakhand has selected ITI Limited as its technology partner in its efforts to curb illegal mining. The Company will leverage its strong technology domain expertise to help Uttarkhand Government achieve its objectives. We are also exploring such projects with other states where we can help them". Shri Rai further stated that, "Illegal mining can lead to deforestation, soil erosion and water pollution that can result in the destruction of habitats for wildlife, which can have serious ecological consequences. It can cause significant economic impact as there will be loss of revenue for governments due to tax evasion. So we are elated to help state Governments in addressing such social issues".

He focussed on topics like how to reduce risks of COPD by quitting smoking, avoiding second hand smoke exposure, use of inhalers and tablets to help breathing easier, pulmonary rehabilitation and surgery or a lung transplant.
