The Bengaluru-based ITI Ltd., India's first post-Independence PSU and telecom manufacturing company, commenced work on the State Network Operations Center (S-NOC) of the monumental BharatNet Phase-III Project at Solan in Himachal Pradesh in coordination with BSNL.

According to ITI, S-NOC is a centralised location where ITI Limited will monitor and manage the performance, security, and availability of the project's

network infrastructure, ensuring efficient delivery of services.

ITI share price rises over 4% as BharatNet Phase-III work begins in Solan

Shares of telecom manufacturing company ITI Ltd jumped 4.08 per cent on the BSE on Wednesday after the announcement of the commencement of operations for the State Network Operations Center (S-NOC) under the BharatNet Phase-III Project at Solan, Himachal Pradesh, in coordination with BSNL.

As part of the project, ITI will connect 3,615 gram panchayats to 91 block headquarters through 10 Gbps bandwidth, which will link to the BSNL IP-MPLS Ring Network.

This will further extend connectivity to 15,538 villages across the State.

The project involves laying about 20,000 km of optical fiber cable (OFC) throughout Himachal Pradesh.

The S-NOC will operate as a centralised hub to monitor

and manage the performance, security and availability of the project's network infrastructure.

Rajesh Rai, Chairman and Managing Director, ITI, said, "Once completed, it will enhance connectivity and make Internet services easily accessible in every village, thereby promoting education, healthcare, business and e-governance."



Once completed, it will transform the digital landscape of the state by enabling access to high-speed internet in every village, thereby promoting education, healthcare, business, and e-governance," he added.
